

# Treasurer Report

From Tom Perro

#### Happy Holidays!

Financial results for October 2024 are as follows: We had a bit of a hiccup in October as we lost \$13,000. Our total income for the month of October was \$178,658 which is \$1,381 lower than the budget. This was due to lower work order income for the month. Operating Expenses of \$191,907 were higher than the budget by \$11,868. This was the result of a few major items beyond our control. Expenses for the Meet and Greet were \$915, Common area tree removal of \$1,100, HVAC repairs in the kitchen \$2,100, Water main break \$3,450. Investment Income was \$1,189. After adding \$34,000 to our Capital Reserves, we ended up with a loss for the month of \$13,249. Year to date our net operating results were a loss of \$8,038.

Our Capital Reserve accounts had a balance of \$667,483 on October 31st.


