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Treasurer Report

From Tom Perro

Greetings!

Our financial results for the month of March are in.

Our total income was \$191,705 which is higher than the budgeted amount of \$189,697 by \$2,008. Operating Expenses were \$155,888, which is \$191 lower than the budgeted amount of \$155,697.

We ended the month with a net profit of \$1,817. Which puts us at a profit of \$2,281 for the nine months of this current fiscal year. This does not reflect the snow deficit of over \$100,000.

Operationally we have expenses of over \$100,000 due to the excessive snow plowing expenses we have incurred. This will be reported as a loss for the year, but I will not report it until the year end. Although our insurance costs increased over 10% The amount budgeted for the year should be sufficient to cover the overage.

It is becoming apparent that we will no longer be able to resist the need for a special assessment to cover the snow plowing expenses.

We are always striving to make Crestwood Village 6 a pleasant, safe, and happy place to live. Help us by attending our events and supporting our clubs and activities!

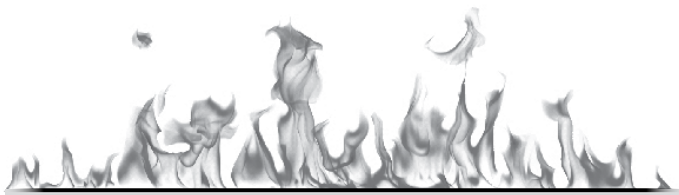
