Trustee Korner...



Hello. I know it's been a while since I've submitted anything. I felt I was repeating myself, so I am taking a new informative approach. When submitting your outdoor home improvement request, keep in mind the Board has 30 days to answer your request. Please don't call the office and ask the staff. They will get back to you when it is approved (or denied) and provide you with the blue copy. If your request is denied, you will get an explanation from the Board and work out any correction, if possible, to get you approved. Many times I will come out and go over the project with you. As fas as the 30-day return answer, we have been averaging a 10-day or less repsonse.

We are allowed as homeowners to work on and improve our homes, so when I see "Self" or family or friends in place of a contractor doing the work, please make sure your HO policy liability insurance is up to date to protect everyone. The office has on file most of the contractors that work here in the village and their liability insurance.

Fences (railings) only around a patio or deck are 42 inches high maximum. Fencing within 3 feet of your home (meaning from the outside wall of your home) to protect your plantings is allowed, decorative black fencing 42 inches high maximum is preferred.

Gazebos must be anchored down at all posts to concrete patio or wood desk. Always check your Rules and regulations in your white binder before submitting your request.

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Treasurer Report

From Tom Perro

Happy Summer!

Our financial results for the month reflect the Special Assessment and snow expenses, so let's look at the results of the ten months ending 4/30/26.

Our total income was \$2,038,895 which includes the Special Assessment of \$171,450. This is lower than the budgeted amount by \$8,638. Admin Fees are under budget by \$10,011 but our Work order income is higher than budget by \$1,381. Operating Expenses were \$1,670,750 which includes snow removal of 168,519. This is lower than the budget by \$8,262. Net income is \$28,145 which is on par with the budget. This is a deceiving number because the income from the special assessment will not be added to the next two months. I am projecting a breakeven by year end.

We have added \$340,000 to our reserves so far this year leaving us with a balance in our reserve account of \$812,746. I am optimistic that we will reach our goal of \$1,000,000 in our reserves at year-end.

We are always striving to make Crestwood Village 6 a pleasant, safe, and happy place to live. Help us by attending our events and supporting our clubs and activities!

- You owned and lived in your home (or leased a site in a mobile home park and lived in your mobile home) in 2022 and through December 31, 2025;
- Your property was subject to property taxes (site fees); and
- You meet the 2024 and 2025 income limits:
 - 2024 — \$168,268 or less
 - 2025 — \$172,475 or less
