Single standing homes have a little more leeway as far as colors on their homes, but as far as patio, deck, screenhouse planting areas, all homes come under the same rules & reg. Side by side homes (aka duplex) with the garages next to each other windows, trim, leaders & gutters all in the same line of sight must match colors. When a request is submitted for a duplex, quad or triplex-type home involving colors I will come out to check the project before giving the ok. Notice all homes involved need to submit a home improvement request form. See page 14 article C in rules & regulations & maintenance programs.

I wanted to share some information about a volunteer opportunity that may be of interest. Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) of Ocean County sounds very formal but I can tell you all about it and their work because I am a CASA volunteer.

CASAs are regular people, like you and me, who want to help children in our community that reside in foster care. After CASA trains you, the Judge will swear you in at the courthouse. A CASA volunteer visits with the children in their foster home (or school, daycare – wherever they are!), builds a relationship with the child and then shares that information with Judges and other adults in the child's life. The CASA volunteer is often the only steady, adult presence in a young child's life.

The child who must be the parent to his siblings.*

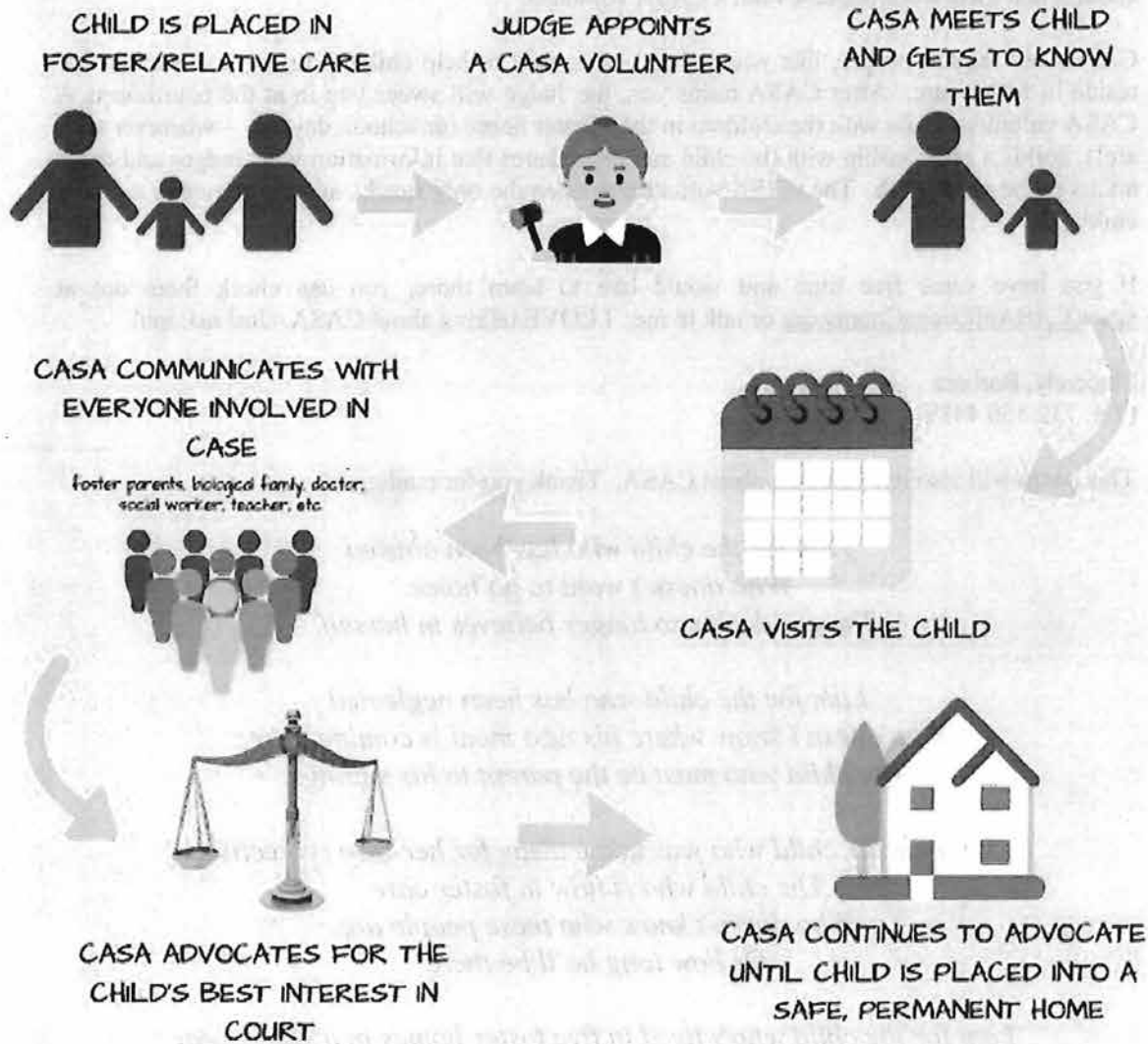
*I am for the child who was taken away for her own protection.

Paper Plate Owl Craft

Here's a fun kids craft idea – turn a paper plate into an adorable owl craft! We made ours into door hangers, but you can do whatever you like with them. Try adding a magnet to the back and displaying your owls on the refrigerator!

Materials Needed

- Paper plates – uncoated basic plates
- Paint – we used acrylic
- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Ribbon for hanging – optional
- Glue – Tacky Glue or hot glue

Instructions

Step 1: Fold both sides of the plate in toward the center.

Step 2: Then fold over the top of the plate to make the owl's head.

Step 3: Now it's time to paint. Open up the plate and paint the inside – just the area shown. Let it dry. Then fold the plate again and paint the head and wings.



Step 4: Use either hot glue or Tacky Glue to glue the wings and head down. Then paint feathers on the body. For younger kids, the feathers can be larger. There's no wrong way to do this!

Step 5: Cut out the eyes, beak, and feet from construction paper.

TIP: Plastic caps are perfect when you need to draw a nice, round circle! I like to save plastic caps in a variety of sizes for crafting.

Step 6: Glue the eyes, beak, and feet to the owl's body, and your owl craft is complete!

You may want to add some ribbon to make your owl a door hanger. It's such a fun way to display the owls!

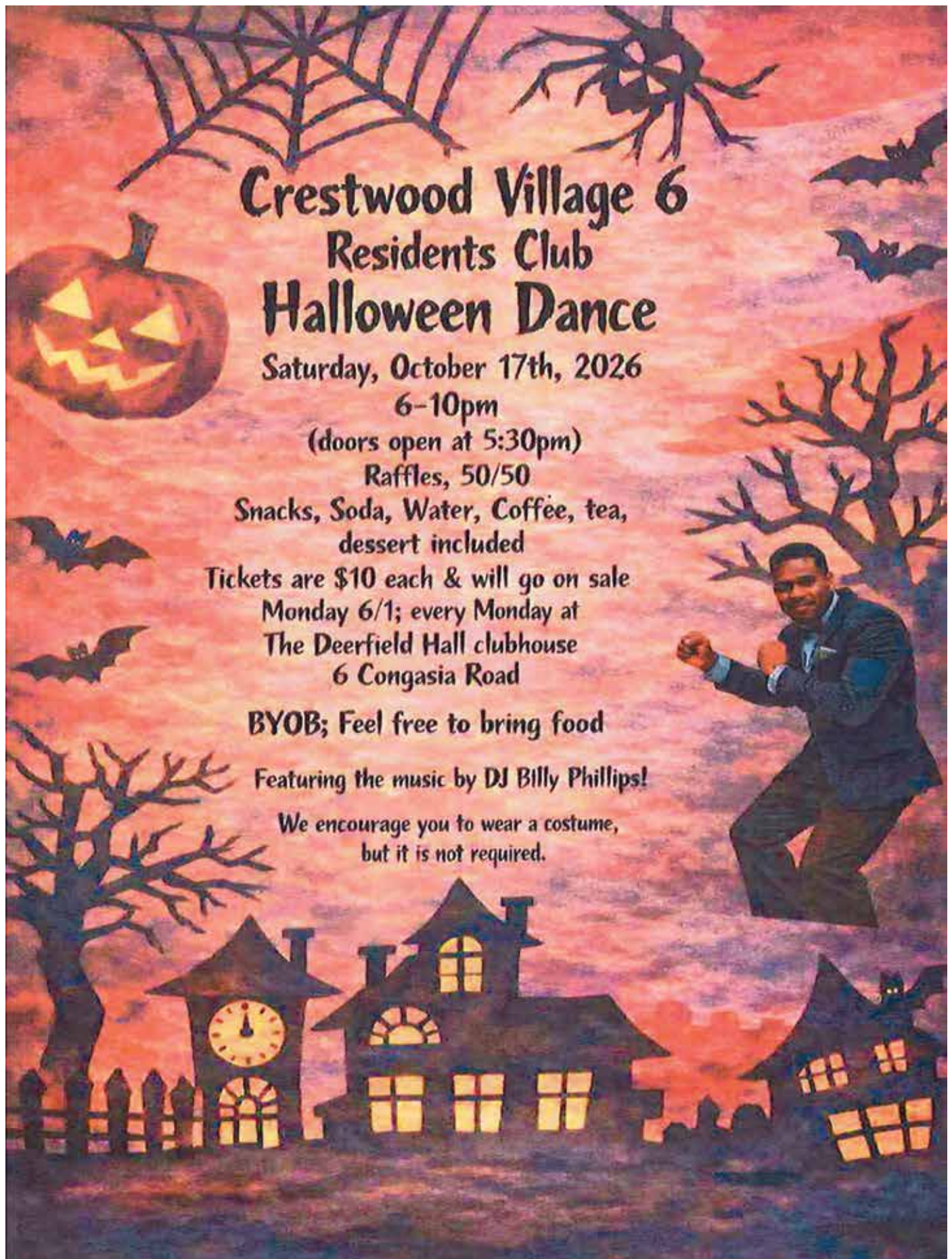

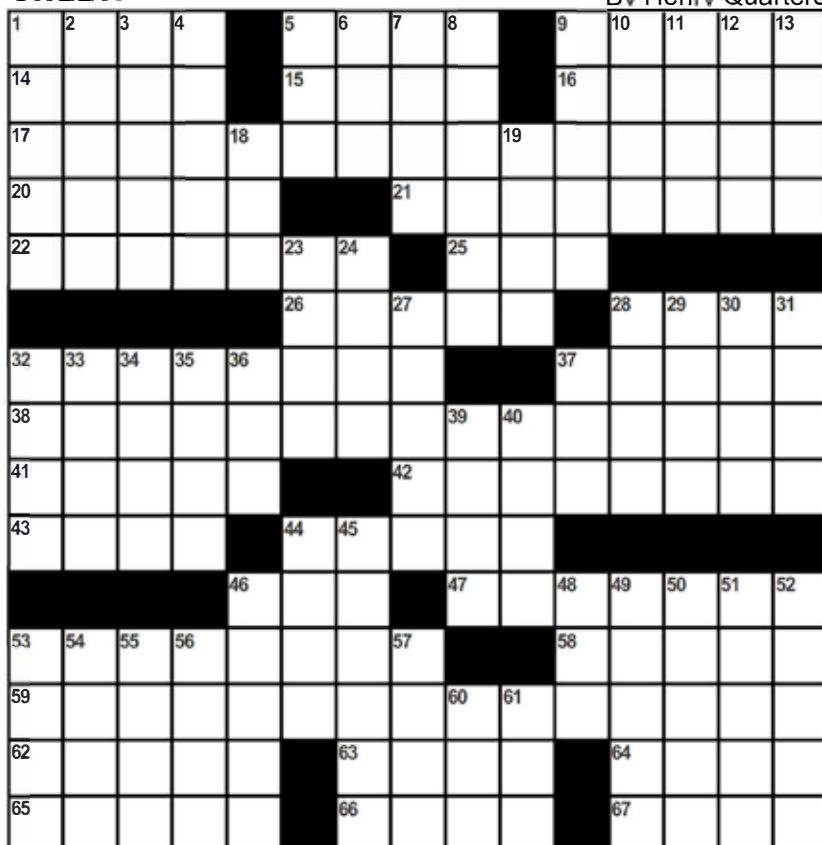

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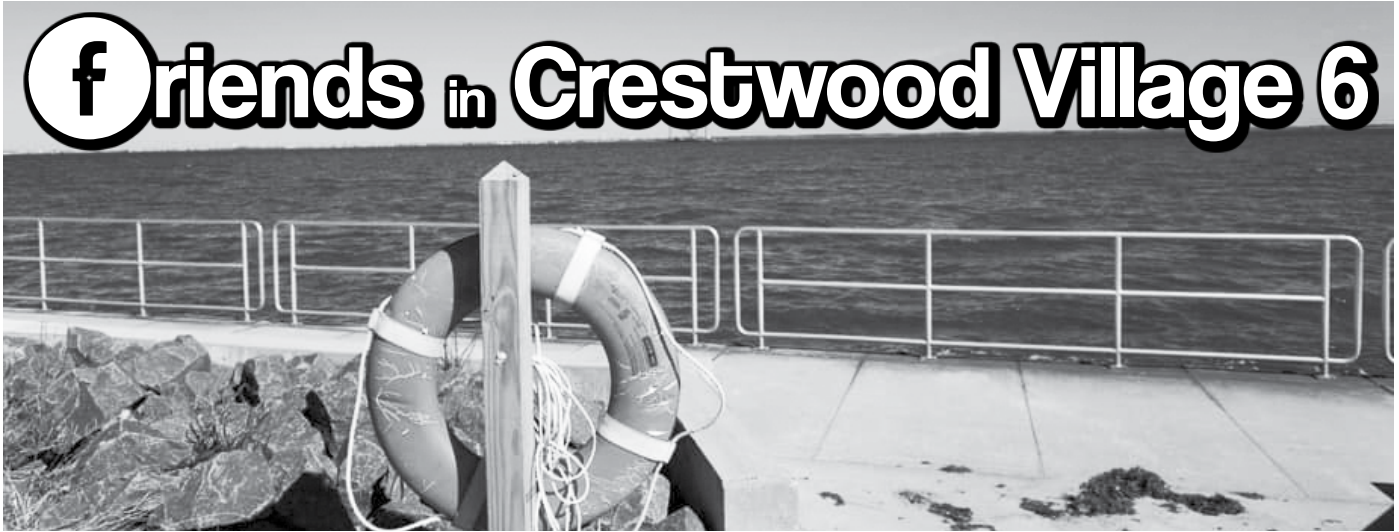

Sunrise And Sunset

Sunrise is getting later in the morning this time of year, so it's a great time to get our sunrise shots.

It is important to use the rule of thirds. Try not to put the sun in the middle of the frame. Place it toward the side. Having something in the foreground will strengthen your image, especially if it is on the opposite side from the sun.

If you want a silky look to the water, use a tripod and a long exposure. Sunrise images are much better with some clouds to reflect the sun's colors.

Check the monitor on the back of your camera to make certain the



exposure is good. Your foreground objects will generally be silhouetted but you want them not to be completely dark.

If you include people in the shot and you don't want them silhouetted use your flash to light them up.
